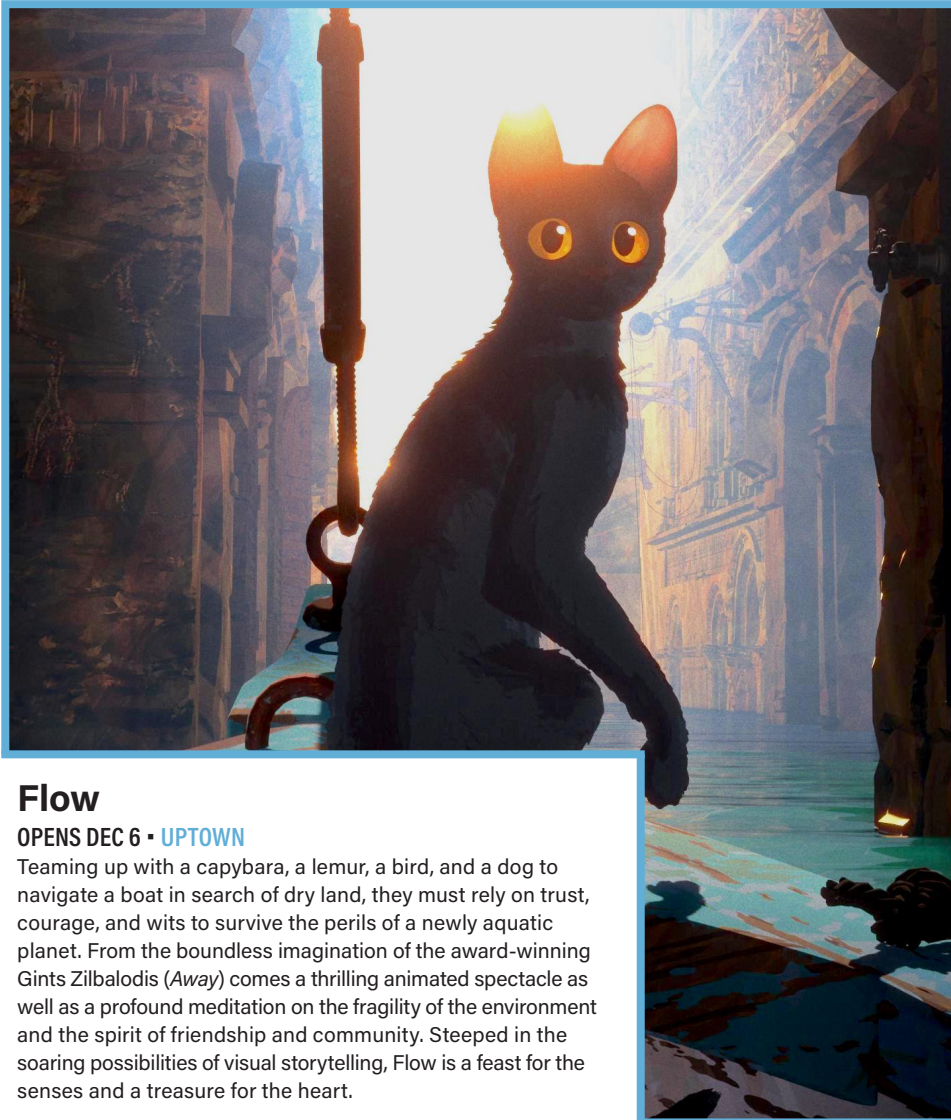

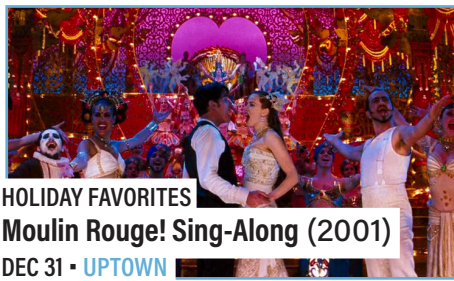
**Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory (1971)**

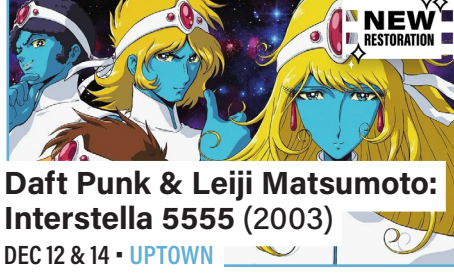
SEATTLE FILM CRITICS SOCIETY AWARDS

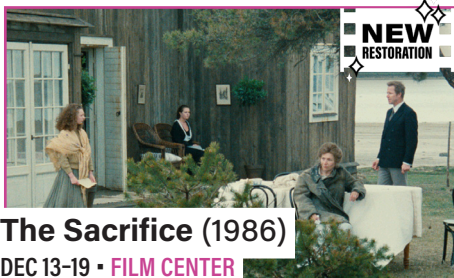
NEW RESTORATION  
**Daft Punk & Leiji Matsumoto: Interstella 5555 (2003)**  
DEC 12 & 14 • UPTOWN

*Interstella 5555* tells the story of the abduction of an alien music band by an evil human character who has dark plans. The hour-long film was cut into music videos to accompany Daft Punk's album "Discovery," and is rare to see in its original form in cinemas.



**A Complete Unknown**  
OPENS DEC 25 • UPTOWN

Set in the influential New York music scene of the early 60s, *A Complete Unknown* follows 19-year-old Minnesota musician Bob Dylan's (Timothée Chalamet) meteoric rise as a folk singer to concert halls and the top of the charts, culminating in his groundbreaking electric rock and roll performance at the Newport Folk Festival in 1965.



NEW RESTORATION  
**The Sacrifice (1986)**  
DEC 13-19 • FILM CENTER

The family descends into a state of psychological devastation, brilliantly evoked by Andrei Tarkovsky's arresting palette of luminous greys washing over the bleak landscape around their home. The film's masterful cinematography is by Sven Nykvist, Ingmar Bergman's longtime collaborator.



**Babygirl**  
OPENS DEC 25 • UPTOWN

A high-powered CEO puts her career and family on the line when she begins a torrid affair with her much younger intern.



**Nosferatu**  
OPENS DEC 25 • UPTOWN

Robert Eggers' *Nosferatu* is a gothic tale of obsession between a haunted young woman and the terrifying vampire infatuated with her, causing untold horror in its wake.
