Celebrate Prince's birthday with this special presentation of *Purple Rain*. Winner of Grammy and Academy Awards for its pulsating song score, experience the electrifying movie debut of Prince as the Kid, a Minneapolis club musician as alienated as he is talented. *New 4K restoration.*



REEL BLACK - SOUL GENRE: Neptune Frost

JUN 23 • EGYPTIAN

A group of escaped coltan miners forms an anti-colonialist computer hacker collective in the hilltops of Burundi. They soon attempt a takeover of the authoritarian regime that's exploiting the region's natural resources—and its people.

Youngho (Sul Kyung-gu) stares down an oncoming train as twenty years of his life flashes before his eyes. Proceeding to move backward in time, the film rewinds his loss of humanity—from his self-hating middle age through his callow teens—mirroring South Korea's traumatic political history. *New 4K restoration.*

Fresh out of prison, Hong Jong-du (Sul Kyung-gu) finds and unlikely soulmate in Gong-ju (Moon So-ri), the disabled daughter of the victim of the hit-and-run for which he went to jail. *New 4K restoration.*

A triptych fable, following a man without choice who tries to take control of his own life; a policeman who is alarmed that his wife, missing-at-sea, has returned; and a woman determined to find a specific someone with a special ability, who is destined to become a prodigious spiritual leader.

Michael Sheen plays Nye Bevan in a surreal and spectacular journey through the life and legacy of the man who transformed Britain's welfare state.

A (very) rare major studio movie about a gay teenager, this adaptation of Becky Albertalli's YA novel "Simon vs. the Homo Sapiens Agenda" is all the more progressive for how familiar it feels, casually reorienting the time-honored heritage of American high school stories for a modern world that's more inclusive.
