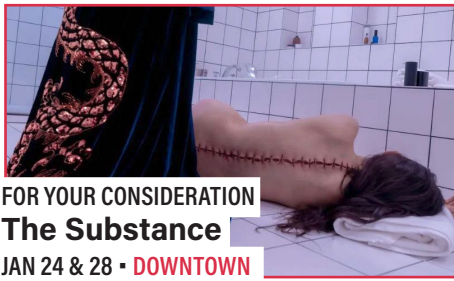

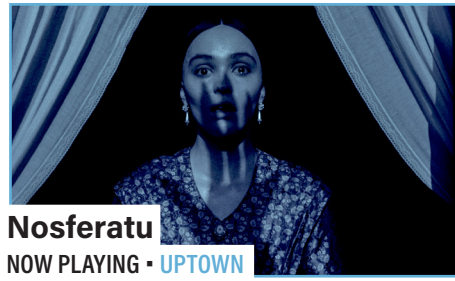

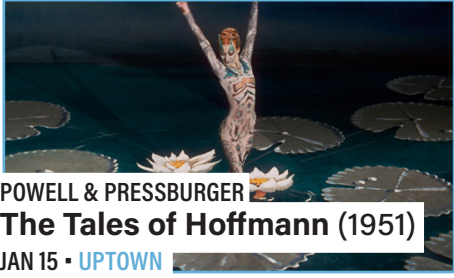
Angelina Jolie stars as Maria Callas, the world's greatest opera singer, as she lives the last days of her life in 1970s Paris, confronting her identity and life.

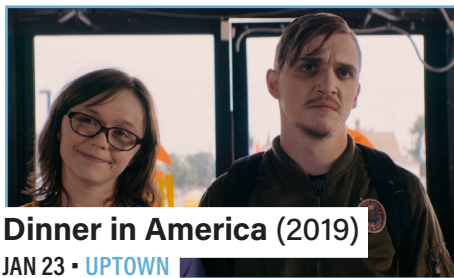

JAN 29 • UPTOWN

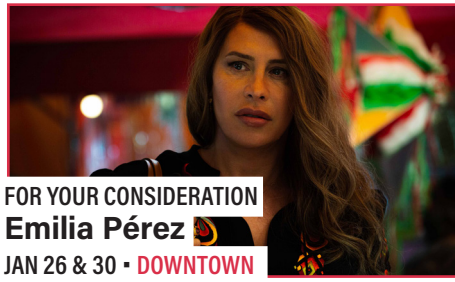

**Bona (1980)**

Lino Brocka's 1980 feature endures as a lively, searing parable on the plight of Filipino women under the Marcos dictatorship. The great Nora Aunor stars as the titular heroine who falls for a womanizing B-movie actor (Phillip Salvador) and abandons her abusive bourgeois family.



**Dig! XX (2004)**

20 years ago, Sundance was rocked by *DIG!*, Ondi Timoner's genre-topping rockumentary. Shot over nearly a decade, *DIG!* explores the collision of art and commerce through the star-crossed friendship and bitter rivalry of dueling 90s bands The Dandy Warhols and The Brian Jonestown Massacre.

Anora, a young sex worker from Brooklyn, gets her chance at a Cinderella story when she meets and impulsively marries the son of an oligarch. JAN 31 & FEB 1 • FILM CENTER

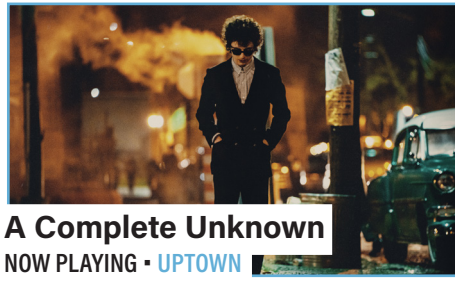
