

Wim Wenders' (*Paris, Texas*) new feature follows the life of Hirayama, a toilet cleaner in Tokyo as he goes about his day in this sweet slice-of-life drama. Through unexpected encounters, Hirayama reflects on finding beauty in the world.



Freshman Charlie is a perpetual wallflower until he falls under the spell of the beautiful, free-spirited Sam and her fearless stepbrother, Patrick; together, the trio navigates love, loss, fear, hope — and the quest for the perfect song.



Documenting an endurance contest at a Texas car dealership with a truck as the prize, this piece of DIY documentary filmmaking was being developed as a feature by Robert Altman before his death and is a cult classic not-to-be-missed. Selected and introduced by SIFF Associate Director Digital Marketing (and fan of eccentric Americana) Clare Garvin.



Shot in 3D and 6K-resolution, the film presents a cinematic experience of artist Anselm Kiefer's work which explores human existence and the cyclical nature of history, inspired by literature, poetry, philosophy, science, mythology and religion.



A teacher working in a remote Turkish village hopes to transfer to Instanbul when he's accused of an inappropriate relationship with one of his pupils in this searing, slow-burn drama from Turkish master Nuri Bilge Ceylan. Best Actress winner at the 2023 Cannes Film Festival.

DOG lives in Manhattan and he's tired of being alone. One day he decides to build himself a robot, a companion. Their friendship blossoms, until they become inseparable, to the rhythm of '80s NYC.



The Peasants tells the story of Jagna, a young woman determined to forge her own path within the confines of a late 19th century Polish village — a hotbed of gossip and on-going feuds, held together, rich and poor, by pride in their land, adherence to colourful traditions and deep-rooted patriarchy.



From Director Rose Glass comes an electric new love story; reclusive gym manager Lou falls hard for Jackie, an ambitious bodybuilder headed through town to Vegas in pursuit of her dream. But their love ignites violence, pulling them deep into the web of Lou's criminal family.



Seven-year-old Sol spends the day helping to prepare a surprise party for her father in this exquisite ensemble drama. The poignant and emotionally expansive film from Lila Avilés (*The Chambermaid*) cements her skill at directing dynamic ensemble performances in her stunning sophomore effort.



In the sultry backdrop of 1960s Louisiana, young Eve navigates a world of betrayal, voodoo, and blurred realities. This Southern Gothic masterpiece unfolds with captivating intrigue, revealing the shadows beneath familial charm.







The chilly landscapes of Helsinki are warmed by the gentle humanism and wry humor of Aki Kaurismäki in the first installment of his *Finland Trilogy*, a deadpan tale of everyday survival in the face of overwhelming obstacles. Misfortune begets misfortune when, in short order, Lauri loses his job as a tram driver and the restaurant where his wife, Ilona, works announces it is closing. As part of our new **Talking Pictures** series, SIFF Board Member and luminary Seattle musician Ben Gibbard (Death Cab for Cutie, The Postal Service) will give an extended introduction about what the film means to him.


